## Rules and regulations

# 30<sup>TH</sup> EUROLAMBRETTA JAMBOREE 2019

The Polish Lambretta Club together with EIGER firm (later referred to as Organizer) will host, on June 13-16, a rally of Lambretta scooter enthusiasts, in the city of Zakopane, Podhale Region in Poland.

This meeting will commemorate the 30th anniversary of EuroLambretta Jamborees.

The following regulations are set forward to help all of us enjoy a safe and fun filled gathering of Lambretta lovers.

1. Please, be advised that the EuroLambretta event is limited to and reserved exclusively for Lambretta scooters produced before 1990.
2. All participants of the rally shall comply with the Polish traffic laws and regulations. There is a mandatory requirement for drivers and passengers to wear a helmet, while riding a motorized vehicle. Any person operating a motorized vehicle is required to have a valid insurance and a driver's license.
3. In orders to help combat air pollution we ask participants to check their vehicles for operating properly and use products that reduce combustion residues and emissions.
4. The rally is open to all members of national Lambretta Clubs and their affiliates, but in order to participate in EL2019, every person:
  - a) must be shown on the list of participants, as prepared by the particular national/regional club; such a list shall be delivered to the Organizer **no later than March 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019;**
  - b) is required to fill out the registration form, which must accompany Club's list of participants. No individual requests for the participation in EL2019 event will be accepted.
  - c) any person without registration document, will not be considered as an official member of the Club's team.

5. The participation fee is 100,00 Euros for adults; for youngsters 12 – 17 years old, the fee is 65,00 Euros and for children 5 – 11 the fee is 30,00 Euros. Kids 5 and younger - free.

The fee covers expenses as indicated in the EL 2019 Program i.e. camping site, breakfasts, dinners, trips with attractions, goodies bag.

The Organizer is requesting registration fees to be paid collectively by each Club for their entire group of participants. **The deadline is set for April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019.**

6. The registration fee will not be refunded under any circumstances, but a replacement for another participant may be allowed, providing the registration formalities are fulfilled.

7. The day of arrival, each participant must check-in with the Organizer, while presenting a valid ID and a copy of the registration document. By signing the registration document, the participant agrees that the Organizer and its representatives will not be responsible in any way for any damages caused by participant's behavior.

8. The Organizer declines all civil and criminal liability for any accident that may occur, involving a participant(s), or for any damage(s) caused by or to third parties, before, during a after the Event. This rule is applicable to the areas enclosed for the Event as a well as to all public and private Polish and European roads.

9. The Organizer will provide means of transporting disabled scooters, from the site of occurrence to the base of the Event. The rider of a disabled scooter is obligated to ensure proper mounting it onto the service vehicle, as the Organizer takes no responsibility for any damage that may occur.

10. The rally participants are expected to make their accommodation **arrangement at the Event's site, as it suits their preferences** and in accordance with the regulations of the campground operator.

**NOTE. The Organizer is strongly suggesting that the participants come for the Event fully and properly insured, taking into account travel through foreign countries. A comprehensive insurance should include European Health Insurance card.**
